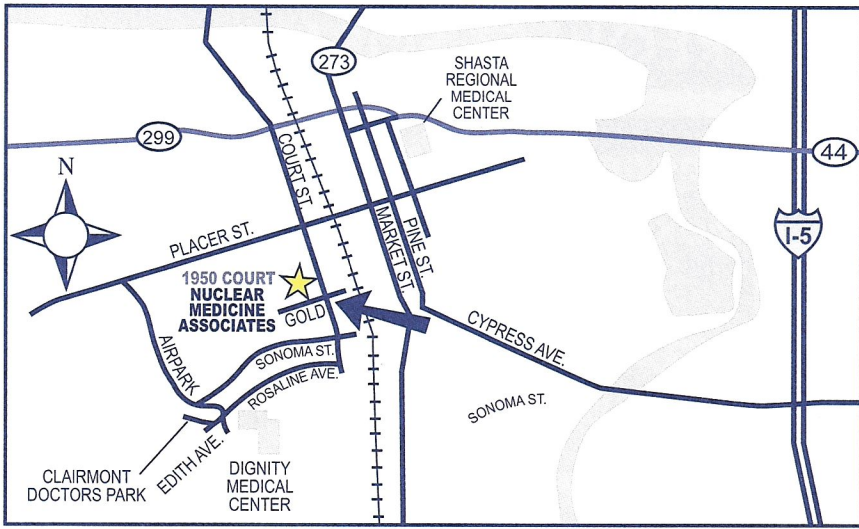

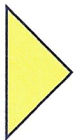


SCAN HERE TO OPEN OUR LOCATION IN GOOGLE MAPS!



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DRIVING DIRECTIONS



From Interstate 5 (North or South bound) or Highway 44

- Take the Highway 44 West/Central Redding exit
- Stay on highway, which becomes Shasta Street
- Turn left at Court Street
- Nuclear Medicine Associates will be on the right between South and Gold Streets.

Prep for your PET/CT scan. Please read carefully.

Do Not's

- DO NOT** Exercise 24 hours prior to your scan.
- DO NOT** Bring children or pregnant women with you due to the risk of exposing them to radiation.

Do's

- DO** Hydrate! Drink as much clear water as you like; at least 3 glasses are recommended before you arrive.
- DO** Take other prescribed medications on the day of your appointment unless otherwise instructed by your doctor. If you need to take medication for pain or anxiety, please bring the medication with you. **You must have a driver.**
- DO** Wear warm, comfortable clothing such as sweats or a jogging suit with no metal if possible. Gowns are available if needed.
- DO** Remember to bring a picture ID and your insurance cards.
- DO** Allow 2 to 3 hours for the procedure.

Prep information for the below procedures will be provided at time of scheduling

| Breast Specific PET/CT | Cerianna (F18 fluoroestradiol) PET/CT Scan for detection of ER+ lesions in patients with recurrent or metastatic breast cancer. |
| Prostate Specific PSMA PET/CT | PSMA PET/CT is approved for initial staging in men with suspected metastasis who are candidates for therapy and for suspected recurrence based on elevated PSA levels. |
| Neuroendocrine Tumor PET/CT | Dotatate PET/CT scan for evaluation and staging of neuroendocrine tumors (NETs). |
| PET Stress Test | Nuclear PET stress test uses positron emission tomography (PET) imaging to visualize blood flow to the heart muscle. |
| Beta - Amyloid for Alzheimer's | PET/CT scan of the brain used for evaluation of Alzheimer's to visualize amyloid plaque. |
